Literacy

- Fact files on endangered animals

Numeracy

- Read and write numbers to at least 100 in numerals and words
- Recognise the place value in each digit in a two digit number
- Identify and estimate numbers using different representations
- Compare and order numbers using < and >
- Count in steps of 2, 3 and 5
- Recall and use addition and subtraction facts to 20 and derive and use related facts up to 100
- Add and subtract numbers - two digit numbers and ones, two-digit numbers and tens

Knowledge and Understanding of the World

- Science - The Environment: Measuring the melting of ice in a comparative test, sort items for recycling based on their materials, investigate the answer to a question, ask and answer questions about the rainforest, set up a test and record the results, ask and answer questions about endangered animals
- RE - Signs and symbols in everyday life
- Computing - E-safety, follow instructions to move through an obstacle course, talk through algorithms, debug sequences, build a word bank for programming

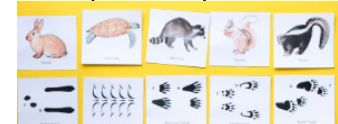
