Literacy

In literacy we will be focusing our learning around the book 'The First Drawings'.

Guided reading, handwriting and SPAG (spelling punctuation and grammar) will be taught alongside literacy lessons.

Underpinning success in literacy is sound phonic knowledge and use of grammar and punctuation.

Numeracy

The units that we will be covering in numeracy are:

- Addition and subtraction
- Multiplication and Division (3,4 and 8 times tables)

The above areas demand a good foundation in skills such as times tables (at least 2, 5, 10), number bonds to 10 (e.g. $2+8=10$) and 20 (e.g. $14+6=20$).
