Literacy

Tadpole's Promise

- Listen to, appreciate and write narratives and non-fiction
- Edit and improve writing, checking for errors in punctuation and grammar
- Use apostrophes to mark where letters are missing in spellings
- Use subordination (when, if, that, because) and co-ordination (and, or, but)
- Write expanded noun phrases for description and specification, using

Numeracy

- Recognise, find, name and write fractions $\frac{1}{2}$, $\frac{1}{3}$, $\frac{1}{4}$, $\frac{2}{4}$ and $\frac{3}{4}$ of a length, shape, set of objects or quantity.
- Write simple fractions, for example $\frac{1}{2}$ of 6 = 3 and recognise the equivalence of $\frac{2}{4}$ and $\frac{1}{2}$
- Choose and use appropriate standard units to estimate and measure length and height in any direction using rulers.
- Compare and order lengths and record the results using <, > and =

Knowledge and Understanding of the World

- RE - Easter - New Beginnings
- Science - Animals (including humans) - Notice that animals have offspring that grow into adults, find out about the basic needs of animals, describe the importance of exercise for humans
- Geography - Skills and Fieldwork - making Safari maps
- Computing - Animating animals and filming news reports
